# UNDERSTANDING 'THE CURSE' BEHIND CURSE WORDS

Hebrew: herem

Greek: anathema

- The serpent was cursed (Gen 3:14 15)
- Cain is cursed (Gen 4:11)
- Curses are completely under God's control (1 Kings 8:31 32)
- A curse cannot be placed on an innocent person (1 Sam 14:24; Prov 26:2)
- Unfaithfulness is the source of all curses
- Faithfulness to God removes the curse (Deut 33:8-10)
- The greatest curse is the curse of sin (Rom 9:3; Gal 3:10,13; Gal 21:23)
- The cure for the curse of sin is the cross of Jesus Christ (Gal 3:10,13)
